Ag Inputs and Pesticides

Dear Pesticide Registrant:

This is your pesticide registration renewal package for the period **July 1, 2011 – June 30, 2012**. Listed on the attached are products we show registered through **June 30, 2012**. Please review this list, and complete your application as directed below.

- 1) Make corrections to product status or company information. List any new products, including the EPA registration number. Adjuvants are denoted by "ADJ" instead of an EPA registration number.
- 2) Tennessee requires a one-year discontinuation unless you affirm that no product remains in the channels of trade. To discontinue a product, write "DISC" to the far right of the line. Products exempt under FIFRA 25-b do not require registration. Manufacturing use-only products must be registered but are exempt from the \$100 fee.
- 3) Submit **one** (1) pesticide label for each product renewal and each new product, or an existing product whose label has changed. We do not require product data sheets, MSDS, or the EPA stamped label. Copies of labels are acceptable. ***If you are submitting more than 10 labels, please have them alphabetized to facilitate the processing of your application.***

We can also accept your pesticide label changes in a PDF format via CD if you create each file as follows. To the left of each renewing product name is a number followed by an underscore and then the products and then the product's EPA registration number. That entire string of numbers, including the dashes and the underscore, is how you should name the file, adding nothing but the extension onto the end. You may send in labels of new products with just the EPA registration number as a file name. ***If possible, please send all pesticide labels in a PDF format via CD.***

- 4) You will receive written confirmation of your approval **ONLY** if you submit a duplicate copy of your registration form. You may also visit <http://www2.state.tn.us/agriculture/onlino/default.asp> and check the status of each product.
Submit payment of **\$100** for each product, including any product you discontinue. Mail it along with the corrected printout to the address below, **attn: pesticide registration**. For overnight delivery other than via the U.S. Postal Service send to:

If you prefer to pay by Master Card, Visa, American Express or Discover you may do so by writing in Your 16-digit account number, name on the account and the expiration date.

Any application postmarked after **June 30th** will be assessed a late fee of **\$50** per renewing product.
