Figure 1. Age




Figure 2. Race




Figure 3. Gender






Figure 4. Education Status



## In FY16 (Jul-Dec.):

- 62% of people in recovery courts were between the ages of 25-39
- 73% were white
- 68% were male
- 75% had a high school education or more
- 26% abused opioids, 19% alcohol, and 19% methamphetamines


Figure 5. Primary Substance of Abuse




# Recovery Court Successful Completion Rates

- In FY15, 49% successfully completed
  - In FY16 (July-Dec.), 59% successfully completed
- Most successful groups:
- 67% of people age 40+
  - 64% of women
  - 68% of those with a high school education or more
  - 75% of those with an alcohol substance abuse disorder


**Figure 6. Completion Rate Overall**




**Figure 7. Successful Completions by Age Group**




**Figure 8. Successful Completions by Gender**
