

Equipment Considerations for Basic SWAT School

A. "Mandatory Items"

1. Eye protection
2. Hearing protection
3. Gloves
4. Head protection, helmet
5. Body armor
6. Load bearing equipment
7. Boots (foot wear)
8. Uniform (battle dress utilities)
9. Camel back, water bag, canteen
10. 600 rounds of handgun, 600 rounds of long gun ammunition
11. Operational "Working" flashlight
12. Gun belt and functional holster (drop leg preferred)
13. One operational flash bang
14. **XXXX PERSONEL HYGIENE KIT W/TOWELS XXXX**
15. Gas mask and mask carrier

B. "Comfort Items"

1. arm pads
2. knee pads
3. insect repellent
4. sun screen
5. zip - lock bags
6. appropriate changes of clothing
7. appropriate clothing for weather conditions
8. "550 cord" or similar rope material
9. duct tape or 100 mile an hour tape
10. black electrical tape
11. knife
12. face paint or balaclava
13. knit cap
14. boot bands (extras)
15. compact flashlight
16. matches or lighter
17. fanny (butt) pack or similar bag to attach to belt or load bearing harness
18. individual checklist to ensure availability of items
