

## G364 Multi-Hazard Emergency Planning for Schools

### **Course Description:**

This course provides schools with the knowledge, skills and tools needed to refine or develop an all-hazards school Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) and to identify how to train and exercise the school EOP. This course follows the guidance set forth in the FEMA Comprehensive Preparedness Guide, CPG101, for developing an emergency operations plan and explains how to utilize the National Incident Management System (NIMS) as the foundation for planning and building partnerships with outside agencies such as law enforcement, fire, and emergency management.

### **Target Audience:**

The course is designed for school administrators, principals, assistant principals, risk managers, school safety coordinators, transportation and food service coordinators, facility/building managers/engineers, nurses, school counselors, public information officers, teachers, local emergency managers, and first responders (law enforcement, fire, etc.) who are interested in comprehensive emergency planning for grades K-12. **Please bring your school or district Emergency Operations Plan to the course.**
