Archaeological Investigations at the Yearwood Site 40LN16 and Site 40LN86 in Fayetteville, Tennessee

The Yearwood Site is located on the second terrace above the Elk River in Fayetteville, Tennessee. Jerry recorded this predominantly Woodland period site with the Tennessee Division of Archaeology in 1973. Salvage archaeology was conducted at this site under the direction of Brian Butler in 1975-76 prior to and during the construction of Lincoln County high school. Many of the artifacts recovered during these investigations are now on display in the Fayetteville-Lincoln County Museum. Jerry will describe this very important Middle Woodland period site and the Mississippian period site 40LN86 –which is located just a short distance away.
