Replicating a Dugout Canoe

Hobart Akin is the Seasonal Interpretive Ranger at Old Stone Fort State Park and has recently been promoted to Graduate Trainee, and is now attending the Park Ranger Academy. This past summer, Hobart turned a poplar log into a dugout canoe, utilizing the burn-out technique that was employed by past Native Americans. Hobart will provide a historic overview of canoe making in the southeast and describe each step in the process of replicating a dugout canoe.


