Course Description

Individuals who send or oversee the transportation of infectious or biological substances must know and understand regulations and changes to regulations that apply to the mode of transportation they employ. This workshop will assist participants in maintaining compliance with the Department of Transportation (DOT), the United States Postal System (USPS), and the International Air Transport Association (IATA) regulations currently in effect. This course is intended for clinical laboratorians, supervisors, laboratory managers, and other personnel involved with the classification of biohazardous substances for transport. Admission preference is given to those whose job requires them to package and ship category A and/or B substances in laboratories in Tennessee. This class is limited to 20 participants.

Course Objectives

1. Discuss the DOT, USPS, & IATA transportation regulations that pertain to packaging & shipping Division 6.2 Materials.
2. Classify specimens according to DOT, USPS, & IATA regulations and properly classify, label, mark, and document packages for transport.
3. Outline the responsibilities of the shipper's employer regarding training, recordkeeping, and the safe handling of specimens.
4. Discuss safety and the OSHA Blood Borne Pathogen Standard as they relate to shipping.
