

## Investing in an offender gives great returns!

Every community benefits when an offender is hired. Through employment, an offender has the opportunity to become a productive, tax-paying member of society who no longer takes, but gives back to the community.

- Hiring an ex-felon may qualify an employer for a tax credit through the Work Opportunity Tax Credit Program (WOTC):

Up to \$1500 upon the completion of at least 120 hours of work.

Up to \$2400 upon the completion of at least 400 hours of work.

- The Federal Bonding Program provides employers of offenders, free of charge, a \$5000 bond to protect against theft and dishonesty.
- Mandatory Drug Testing provided.
- Assistance with WOTC and federal bonding program through partnership with Probation and Parole officers.
- Probation or Parole Officers who are willing to work with employers.
