



Tennessee Insurance Data Security Law Compliance Certification

Pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated § 56-2-1004, each insurer domiciled in Tennessee who does not qualify for an exemption under Tenn. Code Ann. § 56-2-1009 must annually, on or before April 15th, submit a written statement to the Commissioner of the Department of Commerce and Insurance certifying the insurer is in compliance with the Insurance Data Security Law, Tenn. Code Ann. Title 56, Chapter 2, Part 10. Please complete the certification and attestation sections below.

Section 1 – Certification
