

**IDEA WRITTEN ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT
NUMBER 09-040**

Name of the school system:

Williamson County Schools

Description of the violation:

Williamson County Schools failed to grant access to the community to work on Individual Education Program (IEP) Objectives. The student's IEP specified objectives in three areas of need: Social-Emotional Behavior, Communication and Transition that stipulate a community setting. The Goals were constructed and agreed on by the IEP Team in February 2008 for the 2008-2009 IEP. The same goals were agreed on in February 2009 for the 2009-2010 IEP. No action was taken on the community setting goals for the 2008-2009 IEP or the 2009-2010 IEP.

Description of the law or regulation determined to have been violated:

C.F.R. § 300.39 Special Education (a) (1) (3) (i) (ii)

Corrective measures order by the Division of Special Education:

- Williamson County Schools Williamson County Schools must schedule training within thirty days upon the receipt of the Closure Letter from the Division regarding the provision of Special Education as mandated by the IDEA to the appropriate staff in Williamson County Schools. .
- William County Schools must schedule an IEP Meeting within ten (10) school days of receipt of the Closure Letter from the Division with the Complainant to address and offer compensatory services for objectives not implemented in the 2008-2009 and the 2009-2010 IEP.

Final determination of the department:

The Division has received notice and documentation that the appropriate staff in Williamson County Schools has received Professional Development in the area of Special Education as mandated by the IDEA.

The Division has also received notice and documentation that an IEP Meeting with the Complainant to discuss and agree upon compensatory services for objectives not implemented in the 2008-2009 and 2009-2010 IEP has been finalized.
