

IDEA WRITTEN ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

Name of the school system:

Metropolitan Nashville Public Schools (MNPS)

Description of violations:

No provision of an Individual Education Program (IEP) since the beginning of the 2014-15 School Year.

Description of the laws or regulations determined to have been violated:

34 C.F.R. §300.101 Free appropriate public education (FAPE) (a) A free appropriate public education must be available to all children residing in the state between the ages of 3 and 21, inclusive, including children with disabilities;

34 C.F.R. §300.323 When IEPs must be in effect (a) (d) (i) (ii);

Corrective measures ordered by the department:

Within thirty (30) days of receipt of this report schedule professional development regarding the aforementioned regulations for appropriate staff of MNPS.

Within thirty (30) days of receipt of this report an IEP Meeting must be scheduled and conducted. MNPS must provide TDOE with written evidence that an IEP has been written for the 2015-16 school year and that a compensatory service plan has been addressed and finalized. If no agreement is reached on these items, MNPS must provide TDOE with evidence of prior written notice to the parent of its actions.

Final determination of the department:

The Department will monitor MNPS for compliance with the corrective measures ordered.
