There will be a public hearing before the Technical Secretary of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Board to consider revisions to the state of Tennessee and Tennessee Local Programs Annual Monitoring Network Plans. An annual evaluation of these plans is required by 40 CFR 58.10.

The hearing will be conducted as prescribed by the Uniform Administrative Procedures Act, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-5-201 et. seq. and will take place at the date, time and location indicated above.

The public hearing has been called to consider revisions to the Tennessee and Tennessee Local Programs Annual Monitoring Network Plans. The state of Tennessee and the Tennessee Local Programs are required by 40 CFR 58.10 to prepare and submit annual monitoring network plans which provide documentation of the establishment and maintenance of an air quality surveillance system consisting of a network of monitoring stations along with any proposed network modifications. The plan must also ensure that all requirements within appendixes A, B, C, D, and E of Part 58 are being met. The Tennessee and Tennessee Local Programs Annual Monitoring Network Plans may be viewed or downloaded from the Tennessee Air Quality Monitoring & Forecasting website:

All persons interested will be allowed to present testimony to the hearing officer regarding the Tennessee and Tennessee Local Programs Annual Monitoring Network Plans. Anyone desiring to make oral comments at this public hearing should prepare a written copy of their comments to submit to the hearing officer at the hearing. The hearing officer may limit the length of oral comments in order to allow all parties an opportunity to speak; and will require that all comments be relevant to the Tennessee or Tennessee Local Programs Annual Monitoring Network Plans. Written statements not presented at the hearing will only be considered part of the record if received by close of business (4:30 PM Central) on June 21, 2024, addressed to the office of the Division of Air Pollution Control at 500 James Robertson Parkway, 7th Floor, Nashville, TN 37243. Comments may also be submitted via e-mail to Air.Pollution.Control@tn.gov.
