## WUI in the Southern Region

## If we look just at WUI in 2020, the South has:

- 3 states in the top 5 for 2020 WUI area in km2 (in order- *North Carolina; Texas*; Pennsylvania; *Georgia;* New York)
- 3 states in the top 5 for 2020 WUI housing units (California; *Texas; Florida; North Carolina;* Pennsylvania)
- 1 state in the top 5 for percent of state area in WUI in 2020 (Connecticut; Massachusetts; New Hampshire; Rhode Island; *North Carolina*)

## Growth of WUI in the South over the past decade (2010-2020), the South has:

- 4 states in the top 5 for WUI area expansion in km2 (*Texas; Tennessee; Florida;* Washington; *Mississippi*)
- 1 state in the top 5 for WUI percent growth in area (North Dakota; South Dakota; *Texas;* Idaho; Montana)
- 4 states in the top 5 for growth in number of WUI houses (*Texas*; *Florida*; California; *North Carolina*; *South Carolina*)
- 2 states in the top 5 for percent growth in WUI houses (North Dakota; *Texas;* Utah; Nevada; *Florida*)

## Growth of WUI in the South over the entire time period (1990-2020), the South has:

- The top 9 states for WUI area expansion in km2 in the US (*Texas; Georgia; North Carolina; Virginia; Tennessee; Mississippi; Alabama; Florida; South Carolina*)
- No states in the top 5 for WUI percent growth in area
- 3 states in the top 5 for growth in number of WUI houses (California; *Texas; Florida; North Carolina;* Arizona)
- 1 state in top 5 WUI percent growth in housing units (Nevada; Arizona; Utah; *Florida*; Colorado)
