EXAMINATION METHOD: The examination consists of a multiple choice written test. To be eligible for employment consideration an applicant must attain a passing score of 70 or greater on the test. An applicant's standing or rank on an eligible list is based on this score.

TEST SUMMARY: The written test consists of 90 multiple choice questions organized into five test sections. The test sections have been designed to assess the knowledge, skills, and abilities required to effectively perform the job. The five test sections are:

Mathematics - Questions assess an applicant's knowledge of mathematics involving percentages, equations, areas, volumes, angles, and distances. (23 questions)

Plant Operations - Questions assess an applicant's ability to solve problems required in monitoring plant operations and in related duties. (11 questions)

Surveying - Questions assess an applicant's knowledge of surveying. (23 questions)

Maps, Plans, and Tables - Questions assess an applicant's knowledge of maps, plans, and tables. (17 questions)

Structures - Questions assess an applicant's knowledge of nomenclature, deficiencies, inspection equipment, scour and erosion, and construction. (16 questions)
