**VETERANS' EMPLOYMENT REP 1**

**EXAMINATION METHOD:** The examination for Veterans' Employment Rep 1 consists of a multiple choice written test. To be eligible for employment consideration an applicant must attain a passing score of 70 or greater on the test. An applicant's standing or rank on an eligible list is based on this score.

**TEST SUMMARY:** The written test consists of 75 multiple choice questions divided into four individual test sections. Each test section has been designed to assess the knowledge, skills, and abilities required to effectively receive the training provided to new employees. Test sections are:

**Making Decisions in Job Situations** - The questions in this section are designed to assess the extent to which the applicant will be able to effectively make decisions regarding actions to take in situations routinely encountered on the job. (35 Questions)

**Reading Passages and Answering Questions about Content** - The questions in this section are designed to assess the extent to which the applicant will be able to learn specific components or aspects of the job through the reading of written material by measuring his or her ability to read passages and answer questions about the content of the passages. (15 Questions)

**Word Meanings** - The questions in this section have been designed to assess the applicant's communication skills by measuring his or her knowledge of word meanings. (10 Questions)

**Recognizing Errors in Sentences** - The questions in this section have been designed to assess the applicant's writing ability by measuring the extent to which he or she can detect either grammatical or standard English usage errors in sentences. (15 Questions)
