1. **High priority Schools** identified on the 2010-11 High Priority list, will submit the following to the **Local Education Agency (LEA)** (not the State Education Agency) on or before **April 7, 2011***.
 - a. Attached School Level Excel Data Form(s)
2009-10 column for each appropriate worksheet based on grades served
 - b. Goals and Action Steps (revised to reflect the most current data)

2. **High priority Systems** identified on the 2010-11 High Priority list, will submit the following to the State Education Agency (SEA) on or before **April 7, 2011***.
 - a. Attached System Level Excel Data Form(s)
2009-10 column for each appropriate worksheet based on grades served
 - b. Goals and Action Steps (revised to reflect the most current data)

3. **High priority Schools and Systems** that are in Corrective Action and beyond will have additional requirements that will be communicated directly to the school or system.

4. **Good Standing and Target Systems and Schools** will have additional information forthcoming regarding the planning process and submission schedule. As always, system and school personnel should be continually reviewing and revising plans, using the most current data, to improve student achievement.
