

2009 Summer Standards Training NCLB 2009 AYP Training

The Office of Accountability, Teaching and Learning is pleased to offer the ***2009 Summer Standards Training!*** Upon completing this summer training, participants will be qualified to replicate the training in their school systems.

Please register those who attended last summer's workshops as **returning participants**. They will participate in the grade band, content strand they attended last summer - Language Arts/English K-12, Mathematics K-12, or Science/Biology K-12. The focus will be on implementing standards and enhancing content knowledge. If you have a teacher who is not returning, you may register a replacement as a **new participant**.

These **new participants** will receive an overview of last summer's workshops, and build upon that information with new learning in Day Two and Day Three with returning participants.

Additional two-day offerings will be available for **new participants** in Reading K-2, 3-5, 6-8, 9-12 and Physical World Concepts 9-12 only. They will not attend Day One training.

School systems may register a maximum of two teachers per content area and grade band (K-2, 3-5, 6-8, 9-12). Register these as a New Participant.

A new, one-day institute is offered for Directors, Principals or Instructional Supervisors. **District leaders** will attend an overview of the 2009 Summer Standards Training to help them support their teachers' efforts. This institute will provide a condensed training aligned to the offerings provided to teachers in Day One - Three Summer Trainings. **This year's NCLB 2009 AYP training will take place during the one-day institute for Administrators.**
