

New Source Review newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications, February 20, 2011. The following public notices have been published in the newspapers listed below each advertisement. These newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications were published on one of the following dates: February 18, February 19, or February 20, 2011. Public notices are generally published every two weeks. The previous publication of public notices was February 3, 2011.

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (TDAPC) has received requests for construction and/or modification of air contaminant sources as noted below. The proposed construction and/or modification is subject to part 1200-3-9-.01(1)(h) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations, which requires a public notification and 30-day public comment period. Interested parties may express their comments and concerns in writing to Mr. Barry R. Stephens, Director, Division of Air Pollution Control, 9th Floor, L & C Annex, 401 Church Street, Nashville, Tennessee 37243-1531 within thirty (30) days of the date of this notice. Questions concerning a source may be addressed to the assigned Division personnel at the same address or by calling 615-532-0554.

Individuals with disabilities who wish to participate should contact the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation to discuss any auxiliary aids or services needed to facilitate such participation. Such contact may be in person, by writing, telephone, or other means, and should be made no less than ten days prior to the end of the public comment period to allow time to provide such aid or services. The applicant is Alcoa Gas Producers, LLC with a mailing address of 10600 Nations Ford Road, Suite 150, Charlotte, NC 28273. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 05-0303-01/64266) for construction of a 1,434 Hp Internal Combustion Engine at 250 Long Powers Road, Friendsville, TN 37737. This proposed operation would consist of an internal combustion engine to drive a 999 kW electrical generator. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Ms. O. Jacobsen is the assigned Division person.

For the Blount County "Maryville Daily Times"--published once on or before Thursday, February 17, 2011.

The applicant is Vulcan Construction Materials, L.P. with a mailing address of P.O. Box 7, Knoxville, TN 37901. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 06-0021-03/64265) for modification of a Rock Crushing Operation located on 3854 Bates Pike, Cleveland, TN 37323. This existing operation consists of a feeder, crushers, screens, conveyors, bins, wash screws, pugmill, air separator, and associated equipment used to produce crushed rock. Wet suppression is used for pollution control. The requested modification is to increase the throughput for the facility. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants emitted by this source would increase. Mr. M. Reynolds is the assigned Division person.

For the Bradley County "Cleveland Daily Banner"--published once on or before Thursday, February 17, 2011.

The applicant is B & W Pipeline, LLC with a mailing address of 5950 Berkshire Ln., Suite 260, Dallas, TX 75225. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 25-0079-00/64236) for construction of a Treating Facility to be located at Hwy. 52, 0.25 mi South of Baseline Road near Allardt, TN. This proposed construction would consist of natural gas dehydration units and associated equipment used to provide compression and dew point control services to several gas wells to be drilled near the location. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of air pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be

physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Ms. E. Peeler is the assigned Division person.

For the Fentress County “Fentress Courier” – published once on or before February 17, 2011.

The applicant is Tate and Lyle Ingredients Americas, Inc. with a mailing address of 2200 E. Eldorado Street, Decatur, IL 62521. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number 53-0081-16/64260) for the modification of their existing Wet Mill/Feedhouse Area located at 198 Blair Bend Drive, Loudon, TN 37774. This existing area is made-up of germ, gluten, fiber and feed dryers. The requested modification will combine the heat input rating for the gluten dryer and feed dryer #2 into one rating. Emissions from the dryers are controlled by cyclones, wet scrubbers and thermal oxidizers. There will be no emission increase from this modification. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air pollutants are emitted by this source. Mr. Steven Simpson is the assigned Division person.

For the Loudon County “News-Herald” – to be published once on or before February 17, 2011.

The applicant is Dan’s Polishing Shop with a mailing address of 145 Duren Industrial Drive Adamsville, TN 38310. They seek to obtain air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 55-0156-01/64194) for a chrome-nickel electroplating and polishing operation at same location. The operation consist of an electroplating tank, nine polishing machines, and bead blasting equipment. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Pollution control consists of a wetting agent in the electroplating tank, and filter control for the bead blasting. Mr. Thomas Krinov is the assigned Division person.

For the McNairy County “Independent-Appeal”- published once on or before Thursday, February 17, 2011.

The applicant is Tennessee Aluminum Processors, Inc. with a mailing address of 7207 Hoover Mason Road, Mount Pleasant, TN 38474. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 60-0123-01/64259) for construction of a baghouse located at the same address. This proposed operation would consist of a baghouse for controlling dust in the salt cake holding building. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. K. McLain is the assigned Division person.

For the Maury County “Daily Herald”--published once on or before Thursday, February 17, 2011.

The applicant is General Shale Brick, Inc. with a mailing address of P. O. Box 3547 Johnson City, TN 37602. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number 82-0290-01/64268) for modification of a Cinder/Concrete Block Manufacturing Operation located at Mountain View Drive/Tri-County Industrial Park, Piney Flats, TN 37686. This existing operation consists of an aggregate pile, hoppers, four aggregate storage bins, conveyors, two cement storage silos, two flyash storage silos, and associated equipment used to manufacture concrete blocks. Dry filters and wet suppression are used as pollution control equipment. The requested modification is for the addition of a storage silo for the storage of white cement. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants emitted by this source would increase. Ms. Jacobsen is the assigned Division person.

For the Sullivan County “Kingsport Times-News”--published once on or before Thursday, February 17, 2011.

The applicant is Weir Minerals - Linatex with a mailing address of 1550 Airport Road, Gallatin, TN 37066. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 83-0181-04/64238) for a Cleaver Brooks Model ICB 10.206 MMBtu/hour natural gas fired Boiler located at 1550 Airport Road, Gallatin, TN 37066. The proposed operation will consist of equipment used in surface coating operations. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be physical

construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. Doug Wright is the assigned Division contact.

For the Sumner County "News Examiner"--published once on or before Thursday, February 17, 2011.

The applicant is Coca-Cola Refreshments USA with a mailing address of 174 Refreshment Lane, Cleveland, TN 37311. They seek to obtain air contaminant permits (Division identification number: 06-0279-01/64218 and 06-0279-02/64225) for modification of Natural Gas Fired Boilers located at the same address. This existing operation consists of two (2) natural gas fired-boilers and associated equipment used. The requested modification is to replace burners, tubes and economizers. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. W. Collins is the assigned Division person.
