

New Source Review newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications, January 19, 2012. The following public notices have been published in the newspapers listed below each advertisement. These newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications were published on one of the following dates: January 17, January 18, or January 19, 2012. Public notices are generally published every two weeks. The previous publication of public notices was January 5, 2011.

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (TDAPC) has received requests for construction and/or modification of air contaminant sources as noted below. The proposed construction and/or modification is subject to part 1200-3-9-.01(1)(h) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations, which requires a public notification and 30-day public comment period. Interested parties may express their comments and concerns in writing to Mr. Barry R. Stephens, Director, Division of Air Pollution Control, 9th Floor, L & C Annex, 401 Church Street, Nashville, Tennessee 37243-1531 within thirty (30) days of the date of this notice. Questions concerning a source may be addressed to the assigned Division personnel at the same address or by calling 615-532-0554.

Individuals with disabilities who wish to participate should contact the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation to discuss any auxiliary aids or services needed to facilitate such participation. Such contact may be in person, by writing, telephone, or other means, and should be made no less than ten days prior to the end of the public comment period to allow time to provide such aid or services. The applicant is Horsehead Corporation with a mailing address of P.O. Box A, Rockwood, TN 37854. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 07-0107-14/65139) for modification of an existing Indoor Material Handling (Feed building) Operation located at the 199 Truck Route, Rockwood, TN 37854. This existing operation consists of various conveyors, hoppers etc. The modification consists of installation of a fabric filter that will replace existing baghouses in the Feed Building. There would be physical construction. There are regulated air contaminants emitted by this source. Ms. S. Shajikumar is the assigned Division person.

For the "Roane County News"--published once or before January 19, 2012.

The applicant is Stud Welding, Inc. with a mailing address of 2296 Skyview Drive, Centerville, TN 37033. They seek to obtain air contaminant permits for air contaminant sources located at the same address, as follows:

(1) Shot Blasting Operation (Division identification number: 41-0062-02/65105). This existing operation consists of a wheel-a-brator type abrasive blasting machine to propel abrasive blasting media to remove rust, paint, and scale from fabricated structural steel bridge parts. A dust collector with a cartridge filter is used for pollution control. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Mr. J. Fuss is the assigned Division person.

(2) Welding Operation (Division identification number: 41-0062-04/65106). This existing operation consists of arc welding equipment used to form fabricated structural steel bridge parts. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Mr. J. Fuss is the assigned Division person.

For the "Hickman County Times"--published once on or before Thursday, January 19, 2012.

The applicant is Highway 47 Lumber Co. LLC with a mailing address of 2785 Highway 47 North, Whitebluff, TN 37187. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 43-0085-01/65119) for construction of a Wood Chipping Operation located at 2877 Scepter Road, Waverly, TN 37134. This proposed operation would consist of one (1) wood chipper and associated diesel engine used to debark and chip logs. Due to the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. W. Collins is the assigned Division person.

For the Humphreys County "News Democrat" -- published once on or before Thursday, January 19, 2012.

The applicant is Beach Oil Company with a mailing address of 631 MLK Parkway, Clarksville, TN 37043. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 63-0216-01/65208) for a proposed Gasoline Dispensing Facility at 4015 Trenton Road, Clarksville, TN 37043. This proposed operation would consist of three (3) underground tanks and ten (10) gasoline dispensing nozzles. Stage I vapor recovery would be used for pollution control. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. M. Reynolds is the assigned Division person.
