

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Robinette Company has applied to the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Division (TAPCD) for a [federally enforceable state operating permit](#) to opt out of being subject to the provisions of paragraph 1200-03-09-.02(11) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations (also frequently referred to as Title V regulations). **The Robinette Company** (Division identification number 82-0223/62957) has agreed to be bound by a permit that limits their potential to emit for volatile organic compounds (VOC) such that they are below the applicability threshold of 100 tons per year for VOC. The Robinette Company has also agreed to use record keeping to prove that they are abiding by more restrictive emission limits.

The TAPCD has made the determination that this facility can be approved to opt out of being subject to Title V regulations if certain conditions are met.
