

New Source Review newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications, September 3, 2009. The following public notices have been published in the newspapers listed below each advertisement. These newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications were published on one of the following dates: September 1, September 2, or September 3, 2009. Public notices are generally published every two weeks. The previous publication of public notices was August 20, 2009.

### PUBLIC NOTICE

The Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (TDAPC) has received requests for construction and/or modification of air contaminant sources as noted below. The proposed construction and/or modification is subject to part 1200-3-9-.01(1)(h) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations, which requires a public notification and 30-day public comment period. Interested parties may express their comments and concerns in writing to Mr. Barry R. Stephens, Director, Division of Air Pollution Control, 9<sup>th</sup> Floor, L & C Annex, 401 Church Street, Nashville, Tennessee 37243-1531 within thirty (30) days of the date of this notice. Questions concerning a source may be addressed to the assigned Division personnel at the same address or by calling 615-532-0554.

Individuals with disabilities who wish to participate should contact the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation to discuss any auxiliary aids or services needed to facilitate such participation. Such contact may be in person, by writing, telephone, or other means, and should be made no less than ten days prior to the end of the public comment period to allow time to provide such aid or services. The applicant is Materials and Energy Corporation with a mailing address of 2010 Highway 58, Suite 1020, Oak Ridge, TN 37830. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 73-0163-03/62974) for a Natural Gas-Fired Boiler located at the same address. This existing operation consists of one 300-horsepower natural gas-fired boiler. Low-NO<sub>x</sub> burners are used for pollution control. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Mr. T. Blake is the assigned Division person.

The applicant is TRS, Inc. with a mailing address of 290 Owen Payne Lane, Tazewell, TN 37879. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number 13-0102-01/62871) for construction of a Portable Rock Crushing Operation located at 4586 Highway 25-E, Tazewell, TN 37879. This proposed operation would consist of crushers, conveyors, screens, and associated equipment used to produce crushed limestone aggregate. Wet suppression would be used for pollution control. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Ms. Hymelia Craig is the assigned Division person.

#### FIRST APPLICANT:

The applicant is Tennessee Valley Aggregate Company, LLC with a mailing address of P.O. Box 3068, Knoxville, TN 37927. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number 29-0059-01/62924) for construction of a Limestone Quarry Operation located at 455 Owl Hole Gap Road, Rutledge, TN 37861. This proposed operation would consist of crushers, conveyors, screens, and associated equipment used to produce crushed limestone aggregate. Wet suppression would be used for pollution control. There would be

physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Ms. Hymelia Craig is the assigned Division person.

SECOND APPLICANT:

The applicant is Weigel's #68, with a mailing address of P.O. Box 650, Powell, TN 37849. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 32-0278-01/62969) for construction of a Gasoline Dispensing Facility located at 2750 North Davy Crockett Parkway, Morristown, TN 37814. This proposed operation would consist of three gasoline storage tanks and appurtenant gasoline dispensing equipment. Stage I vapor recovery equipment would be used for gasoline emission control. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Ms. Hymelia Craig is the assigned Division person.

For the Hamblen County "Citizen Tribune" - published once on or before Thursday, September 3, 2009.

The applicant is Wow Cleaners with a mailing address of 3277 Fort Campbell Blvd, Clarksville, TN 37042. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 63-0155-01/63005) for modification of a Dry Cleaning Facility located at the same address. This existing operation consists of a dry-to-dry perchloroethylene dry cleaning machine. A refrigerated condenser is used for pollution control. The requested modification is to replace an older model dry cleaning machine with a newer dry cleaning machine. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Mr. W. Collins is the assigned Division person.

The applicant is Eastman Chemical Company with a mailing address of P.O. Box 511, Kingsport, TN 37662. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 82-0259-01/62977) for a Plastics Compounding Facility located at 137 Regional Park Drive, Kingsport, TN 37662. This existing operation consists of plastics compounding facility. Fabric filter is used for pollution control. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Ms. Olga Jacobsen is the assigned Division person.

For the Sullivan County "Kingsport Times-News"-- published once on or before Thursday, September 3, 2009.

The applicant is 21<sup>st</sup> Century Poly, LLC, with a mailing address of P.O. Box 621, Covington, TN 38019. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 84-0113-01/62811) for construction of a Flexographic Printing Operation located at 1110 Jetton Drive, Covington, TN 38019. This proposed construction would consist of two flexographic printing presses with associated ovens to print on clear polyethylene rolls. Because of the amount and type of pollutants, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Ms. Sarosh Kaiser is the assigned Division person.
