

PUBLIC NOTICE

Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) – Gleason Combined Cycle Plant (GCC) has applied to the Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (TDAPC) for [approval to convert an existing simple-cycle combustion turbine electric power generating facility](#) into a combined cycle combustion turbine electric power generating facility. The proposed project will consist of converting the existing combustion turbines to dry low-NO_x combustors, and the addition of heat recovery steam generators with duct burners, a steam turbine, an auxiliary boiler, and other ancillary equipment. No significant increment consumption would be expected. The project is subject to review under the state rule for Prevention of Significant Deterioration of Air Quality (PSD), Paragraph 1200-3-9-.01(4) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations, Department of Environment and Conservation, which requires a public notification and thirty (30) day public comment period.

The TDAPC has reviewed the installation with respect to the above-mentioned PSD regulations. The TDAPC has made the determination that this modification can be approved if certain conditions are met. A copy of the forms submitted by TVA – GCC, and other materials used by the TDAPC in making this determination, are available for public inspection during normal business hours at the following locations:
