FY 2012 Site Treatment Plan for Mixed Wastes
on the U.S. Department of Energy
Oak Ridge Reservation

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) completed the review of the FY 2012 Site Treatment Plan (STP) Revision 16.0 as submitted by DOE on October 13, 2011. After TDEC review of the STP, there are no comments affecting the compliance schedules as submitted by DOE; however, there were several text additions submitted electronically by TDEC that will serve to more completely present background information maintained in the STP. In a meeting with DOE on November 29, 2011, TDEC proposed that to facilitate efficient review and promote paper reduction, information no longer pertinent would be stricken from the final approved Revision of the STP (expected to be identified as Revision 16.2). This will be accomplished in each version of the STP from this point forward with older versions archived. Information (typically milestone related) that is two years older than the current FY will be deleted. Both parties agreed to this proposal.

The STP (Revision 16.0) was returned to DOE to incorporate the edits thereby establishing Revision 16.1, which is conditionally approved as the STP version to receive public comments. At the above-referenced meeting, it was agreed the document versions would be placed on DOE's website for at least 30 days to fulfill the public review requirement of the STP. This commitment to make the STP an electronic document represents a significant advancement in transparency and efficiency.

At the end of the public review and comment period TDEC will, based on the responses, follow the STP requirements by approving the Annual Update of the STP for FY 2012 and establishing Revision 16.2.
