<b>Compliance Date</b>	<b>Comply with the requirements</b> in this Rule	Date of initial startup	January 10, 2011
<b>Initial Notification</b>	<b>Submit</b> an Initial Notification to the regulatory agency that your facility is subject to the Rule	Due no later than 180 days after initial startup <b>OR</b> July 7, 2008, whichever is later	Due no later than January 11, 2010
<b>Notification of Compliance Status</b>	<b>Submit</b> a Notification of Compliance Status that certifies your facility is in compliance with the relevant requirements of this Rule	Must submit and certify compliance status with the Initial Notification - No later than 180 days after initial startup <b>OR</b> July 7, 2008, whichever is later	Submit on or before March 11, 2011
<b>Paint Stripping Operations using more than 1 ton of methylene chloride per year</b>	<b>Submit a statement</b> certifying the facility has developed and is implementing a written Methylene Chloride Minimization Plan in accordance with the Rule	Must submit and certify compliance status with the Initial Notification - No later than 180 days after initial startup <b>OR</b> July 7, 2008, whichever is later	Submit on or before March 11, 2011
<b>Painters</b>	All Spray Painting Personnel <b>must be trained and certified</b> . Training must meet rule specifications	No later than 180 days after hiring <b>OR</b> no later than July 7, 2008, whichever is later	No later than 180 days after hiring <b>OR</b> no later than January 10, 2011, whichever is later
	<b>Validation of Training and Certification</b>	<b>Every Five Years</b>	
	<b>Complete refresher training</b> that meets the requirements of the rule and obtain recertification	A period not to exceed five years after the date the training is completed	
<b>Record Keeping</b>	<b>Maintain copies</b> of records a period of at least five years after the date of each record.	Maintained a total of five years after the date of each record and kept on site during the first two years (printed or electronic form) and readily accessible for inspection

<b>Annual Notification of Changes Report</b>	<b>Submit a report</b> when reportable changes occurred during the calendar year	No later than March 1 following the calendar year the change occurred
<b>Paint Stripping Operations:</b>  (Began using more than one ton of methylene chloride / year <u>since the last</u> notification / report)	1. <b>Submit</b> an Annual Notification of <b>Change</b> report for any calendar year in which more than one ton of Methylene Chloride was used	1. No later than March 1 following the calendar year the change occurred
	2. Develop <b>AND</b> implement a written Methylene Chloride Minimization Plan.	2. No later than December 31 after report was submitted
	3. Submit a Notification of <b>Compliance Status</b> report <b>AND</b> <u>comply</u> with the requirements for paint stripping operations that annually use more than one ton of Methylene Chloride	3. No later than March 1 following the calendar year the change occurred
