

**NOTICE TO PUBLIC OF
PROPOSED ACTION LOCATED WITHIN THE FLOODPLAIN**

The purpose of this notice is to receive public comments on the State of Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation's (TDEC) proposal to use federal funds under the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Lead Hazard Reduction Demonstration Grant Program within a FEMA designated 100-year floodplain. The proposed program would involve removing lead-based paint hazards with abatement and interim control techniques in pre-1978 properties where a child six years and younger live. **The Davidson County target area** contains floodplains and residential project sites could be located within Flood Zones A, AO, AH, A1-A30, A99, V and V1-V30, as designated by the FEMA Flood Insurance Rate Maps. PURPOSE: This project targets Nashville-Davidson County over the 42-month grant period. For the grant, TDEC Lead-Safe Tennessee will: reduce lead-based paint hazards using abatement and interim controls in 242 existing units; provide free training to low to very-low income individuals in lead-based paint abatement; conduct targeted blood lead testing of children less than 6-years; conduct outreach, education and marketing.
