PUBLIC NOTICE OF DECISION TO TRANSFER PERMIT

Alan's Industrial Waste Service Class I Landfill Change of Ownership

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC), Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM), has issued a final permit decision, pursuant to Rule 1200-1-7-.02(3)(i) and (j). of Tennessee's Solid Waste Program Processing and Disposal Regulations. ECM of Ridgely, LLC has applied, pursuant to a change of ownership, for a minor permit modification to transfer the permit for the existing Alan's Industrial Waste Service Class I Landfill (SNL 66-0276), from the previous owner. The facility, which will be identified as ECM of Ridgely Class I Landfill, is located in Obion County, at 2633 Inman Hollow Road (five miles east of Ridgely, TN), Gratio, Tennessee (latitude 36°15'35" N/ longitude 89°24'59" W). The final decision to issue the permit was made on July 29, 2011.
