

NOTICE OF FINAL DECISION TO ISSUE A CORRECTIVE ACTION PERMIT TO NAVAL SUPPORT ACTIVITY MID-SOUTH, MILLINGTON, TENNESSEE

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation's (TDEC) Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM) has made a final decision to issue a hazardous waste management corrective action permit to Naval Support Activity (NSA) Mid-South; EPA Identification Number: TN2 17 002 2600. The facility is located at 5722 Integrity Drive, Millington, Shelby County, Tennessee 38054-5045. The permit, issued on September 29, 2011, shall remain in effect until September 29, 2021, unless revoked and reissued, terminated, or continued under applicable regulations. This action follows a 45-day public comment period, which ended on September 23, 2011. The only comments received during the comment period were from NSA Mid-South. A public hearing was held on September 8, 2011. No members of the public attended, so there was no formal presentation.

The permit (TNHW-149) identifies known solid waste management units (SWMUs) and areas of concern (AOCs) for the NSA Mid-South facility and describes the requirements for institutional controls and long-term monitoring. NSA Mid-South will also be required to investigate any newly identified releases of hazardous waste or hazardous constituents pursuant to the permit, regardless of the time at which waste was placed in a unit, and to take appropriate corrective action for any such releases. In addition, NSA Mid-South will be required to notify of imminent hazards; and as applicable, comply with the requirements developed under land disposal restrictions and organic air emission standards. The permit is issued under Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-212-101 et seq., and Tennessee Rule Chapters 1200-01-11, Hazardous Waste Management.
