

NOTICE

On March 11, 2011 the Tennessee Division of Solid Waste Management (TDSWM) approved a Class 2 Modification of a Post-Closure Corrective Action Order (Order) that allows TPI Corporation (TPI) to terminate further active groundwater remediation efforts at the Bill Morgan Farm Site (EPA I.D. Number: TND 987790839). This corrective action site is located on the southern slope of Ripshin Mountain above Ripshin Lake in southeastern Carter County, Tennessee. TPI closed the site in the mid 1990s, but corrective action in the form of a “pump-and-treat” groundwater remediation system was required. After 17 years, TPI and TDSWM have determined that the remediation system is no longer required. TDSWM’s action modifies the Order, and the Corrective Action Plan approved thereunder, to allow TPI to cease all operation of, and remove, the groundwater remediation system. This action was taken in response to TPI’s request for such a Class 2 Modification, dated September 2, 2010, and following an opportunity for public comment. No public comments were received. Pursuant to the modified Order and Corrective Action Plan, limited groundwater monitoring will continue to verify the natural attenuation at the site.
