NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, the Division of Water Pollution Control will hold a public hearing pursuant to Rule 1200-4-5-.06 (8).

Public comments will be received concerning the draft NPDES Permit for Discharges of Treated Wastewater Associated with TVA - Kingston Fossil Plant - Addition of Flue Gas Desulfurization System. TVA proposes to discharge 1 million gallons per day from a detention pond into the Kingston plant discharge channel which as a flow of approx. 1297 mgd to Clinch River at mile 2.9.

The hearing officer may limit the length of oral presentation in order to allow parties an opportunity to speak, and will require that all testimony be relevant to water quality issues. Written testimony will be accepted at the hearing, for ten working days following the hearing, and will be considered part of the hearing record.

Interested persons may obtain additional information, a copy of the draft permit, the rationale and inspect and copy forms and related documents at the Division's Central Office at the address listed above. You may make an appointment with Ms. Monya Bradley to view the permit by calling (615) 532-0664.

Individuals with disabilities who wish to participate in these proceedings (or review the administrative file record) should contact the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation to discuss any auxiliary aids or services needed to facilitate such participation.
