This is to provide official notification that the Certificate of Need applications listed below have begun the review cycle effective **June 1, 2011**. The review cycle includes a 60-day period of review by the Tennessee Department of Health or the Department of Mental Health. Upon written request by interested parties the staff of The Health Services and Development Agency shall conduct a public hearing. *Certain unopposed applications may be placed on a "consent calendar." Such applications are subject to a review less than 60 days including a 30-day period of review by the Department of Health or Department of Mental Health. Applications intended to be considered on the consent calendar, if any, are denoted by an asterisk.*

Pursuant to T.C.A. Section 68-11-1609(g)(1), any health care institution wishing to oppose a Certificate of Need must file a written objection with the Health Services and Development Agency and serve a copy on the contact person for the applicant no later than fifteen (15) days before the agency meeting at which the application is originally scheduled for consideration.

To construct a comprehensive cancer center; to initiate linear accelerator and positron emission tomography (PET) services; and to acquire major medical equipment and related assets currently owned by Baptist Memorial Hospital-Memphis (BMHM). The new facility will include a full array of oncology services and programs, and will be operated as an outpatient department of Baptist Memorial Hospital-Tipton under the name Baptist Center for Cancer Care. The project involves relocating from BMHM the PET unit, two (2) linear accelerators and other radiation oncology equipment along with the CyberKnife linear accelerator approved but unimplemented by CN1010-050. The PET, accelerators and other treatment equipment and services will be located in approximately 105,291 square feet of space to be constructed at 1238 and 1280 South Germantown Parkway, Germantown (Shelby County), TN 38138. The location is close to the intersection of Germantown Parkway and Wolf River Boulevard in Germantown (Shelby County), TN and is approximately 5 miles from the current location of radiation therapy services at BMHM. The project does not involve the addition of beds or any other service for which a certificate of need is required.
