Applications will be heard **July 27, 2011 Meeting** at the Health Services and Development Agency Meeting (except as otherwise noted as **Consent Calendar which will be heard at the June 22, 2011 Meeting**).

This is to provide official notification that the Certificate of Need applications listed below have begun the review cycle effective **May 1, 2010**. The review cycle includes a 60-day period of review by the Tennessee Department of Health or the Department of Mental. Upon written request by interested parties the staff of The Health Services and Development Agency shall conduct a public hearing. *Certain unopposed applications may be placed on a "consent calendar." Such applications are subject to a review less than 60 days including a 30-day period of review by the Department of Health or Department of Mental Health. Applications intended to be considered on the consent calendar, if any, are denoted by an asterisk.*

Pursuant to T.C.A. Section 68-11-1609(g)(1), any health care institution wishing to oppose a Certificate of Need must file a written objection with the Health Services and Development Agency and serve a copy on the contact person for the applicant no later than fifteen (15) days before the agency meeting at which the application is originally scheduled for consideration.

DESCRIPTION

To renovate and expand several departments of the hospital located at 2051 Hamill Road, Hixson (Hamilton County), TN. The project involves construction of a replacement Intensive Care Unit, renovation and expansion of the Emergency Department, renovation and expansion of the Endoscopy Unit, partial renovation of a Nursing Unit, and renovation of radiology space to add a SPECT-CT unit. The designated ICU beds will increase from eight (8) to ten (10) and the number of medical surgical beds will decrease from sixty-one (61) to fifty-nine (59). This project will not affect the hospital's total licensed bed complement of sixty-nine (69) beds. Emergency Department treatment rooms will increase from thirteen (13) to seventeen (17). The Endoscopy Unit will increase from two (2) to three (3) labs. The total project involves 32,880 total gross square feet of new and renovated space. The project does not involve acquisition of major medical equipment or the initiation or discontinuance of any health care services.
