Article III - 320 of the International Registration Plan**

The estimated distance chart is based on an average per vehicle distance per each Member Jurisdiction by:

1. Determining the total actual distance reported to Tennessee as having been operated in each Member Jurisdiction by Fleets for which Tennessee served as the Base Jurisdiction during the Registration Year;
2. Determining the number of Apportioned Vehicles for which Tennessee served as the Base Jurisdiction during the Registration Year that accrued distance in each Member Jurisdiction and;
3. For each Member Jurisdiction dividing the distance determined by the number of Apportioned Vehicles determined in number 1.
