## SENATE BILL NO. 1166

AN ACT To amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 7-84-519, relative to the central business improvement district act.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 7-84-519(d), is amended by designating the current language as subdivision "(d)(1)" and by inserting the following new language, to be designated as subdivision "(d)(2)":

(2) Alternatively, in any county having a population in excess of eight hundred thousand (800,000) according to the 1990 federal census or any subsequent federal census, the Speaker of the Senate shall appoint as ex officio members of such board of directors two (2) senators whose senatorial districts lie in whole or in significant part within the boundaries of the center city revenue finance corporation, as such boundaries exist on January 1, 1999; and the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint as ex officio members of such board of directors two (2) representatives whose representative districts lie in whole or in significant part within the boundaries of such corporation, as such boundaries exist on January 1, 1999.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
