AN ACT To amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 16-2-506, relative to the chancellor for the fourth and fifth judicial districts.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 16-2-506(4)(A), is amended by deleting the following language:

"Notwithstanding any other provision of law or this part to the contrary, the chancellor currently residing in the fourth judicial district shall also serve the fifth judicial district. As long as the chancellor for the fourth judicial district also serves the fifth judicial district, such chancellor shall be elected by the qualified voters of both such districts."

and substituting instead the following:

"Notwithstanding any other provision of law or this part to the contrary, the chancellor currently serving the fourth judicial district shall also serve the fifth judicial district. As long as the chancellor for the fourth judicial district also serves the fifth judicial district, such chancellor shall be elected by the qualified voters of both such districts and may reside in either district."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
