AN ACT To amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-8-188, relative to high occupancy vehicles.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-8-188, is amended by deleting subsection (d) in its entirety and by substituting instead the following:

(d) A violation of any provision of this section is a Class C misdemeanor, subject only to imposition of a fine, not to exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00), and court costs, not to exceed ten dollars (\$10.00).

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
