AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-11-201, relative to the deeming of homes for aged as assisted care living facilities.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-11-201(4)(B)(ii), is amended by deleting the following language:

It shall be deemed that a facility licensed as a home for aged and meeting the fire and life safety standards for such classification meets the fire and safety standards for assisted care living facility unless the board specifically finds that residents of a specific facility are subject to a significant health safety risk.


SECTION 2. This act shall take effect 270 days subsequent to the revisions to the Board of Licensing Health Care Facilities Rules Revisions to the Standards for Homes for the Aged (Rule 1200-8-11.01 through .12) becoming effective after being approved by the Attorney General and Reporter and being filed with the Secretary of State pursuant to T.C.A. § 4-5-207.
