AN ACT to amend Chapter 325 of the Private Acts of 1980; and any other acts amendatory thereto, relative to the Town of Bruceton.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Chapter 325 of the Private Acts of 1980, and any other amendatory acts thereto, is amended by deleting the first sentence of Article III, Section 3.13 and substituting instead the following:

No employee of the Town may serve as the Mayor nor as an Alderman of the Town.

SECTION 2. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the legislative body of the Town of Bruceton. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the Town of Bruceton and certified to the Secretary of State.


SECTION 3. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective as provided in Section 2.
