AN ACT to amend Chapter 68 of the Private Acts of 1951, as amended by Chapter 29 of the Private Acts of 1959, Chapter 191 of the Private Acts of 1965, Chapter 138 of the Private Acts of 1967, Chapter 34 of the Private Acts of 1971 and any other acts amendatory thereto, relative to the county road supervisor and county highway system of Chester County.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1.

(a) Section 1 of Chapter 68 of the Private Acts of 1951, as amended by Chapter 29 of the Private Acts 1959, Chapter 191 of the Private Acts of 1965, Chapter 138 of the Private Acts of 1967, Chapter 34 of the Private Acts of 1971, and any other acts amendatory thereto, is amended by deleting the second, third and fourth sentences of the section and by substituting instead the following:

The county road supervisor shall serve as the chief administrator officer of the county highway department and shall have qualifications, duties and compensation according to the County Uniform Highway Law codified at Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 54, Chapter 7 and other general law. The county road supervisor shall serve as the purchasing agent for the county highway department.

(b) Section 1 of Chapter 68, as amended, is further amended by deleting the final sentence of the section and by substituting instead the following:

The county road supervisor shall take office upon taking an oath of office and entering into bond in the manner required by general law for the chief administrative officer of the county highway department. In addition to the bond required by general law, the county legislative body, by resolution, may require additional bond of the county road supervisor for the faithful performance of the duties of the office and the safekeeping of property that may come into the care and custody of the county road supervisor.

SECTION 2.

(a) Section 2 of Chapter 68 of the Private Acts of 1951, as amended by Chapter 29 of the Private Acts of 1959, Chapter 191 of the Private Acts of 1965, Chapter 138 of the Private Acts of 1967, Chapter 34 of the Private Acts of 1971 and any other acts amendatory thereto, is amended by deleting the following words and punctuation:

, which rate of pay so far as wages scales by concerned shall be approved by the County Judge of counties to which this Act applies.

(b) Section 2 of Chapter 68, as amended, is further amended by deleting the words "Quarterly County Court" and by substituting instead the words "county legislative body".

(c) Section 2 of Chapter 68, as amended, is further amended by deleting the words "County Judge" from the final sentence and by substituting instead the words "county executive".

SECTION 3. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the legislative body of Chester County. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the county legislative body and certified to the secretary of state.

SECTION 4. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective as provided in Section 3.
