AN ACT To amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 45, Chapter 10, relative to financial records privacy.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 45-10-103, is amended by adding as a new appropriately numbered item the following:

"The furnishing by a financial institution of information or records to the extent permitted by the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act of 1999 (Public Law 106-102) provided the financial institution complies with the consumer disclosure requirements and opt-out provisions of such act."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
