AN ACT To amend TCA § 57-4-203 relative to the sale of beverages of alcoholic content of not more than five percent (5%), by weight, to minors.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-203(b)(1), is amended by designating the existing language as subdivision (A) and by adding the following language as a new subdivision (B):

(B) Any licensee engaging in business regulated hereunder or any employee thereof who sells, furnishes, disposes of, gives, or causes to be sold, furnished, disposed of, or given any beer or malt beverage as defined in §57-6-102 to any person under twenty-one (21) years of age is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.


SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001, the public welfare requiring it.
