HOUSE BILL NO. 1039

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 16-16-201, relative to the clerk of court having probate and administration of estate duties in counties having a population of not less than twenty-two thousand two hundred seventy-seven (22,277) nor more than twenty-two thousand three hundred fifty (22,350) according to the 1980 federal census of population or any subsequent federal census.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 16-16-201, is amended by deleting subsection (d) in its entirety.

SECTION 2. All records, files, papers and other documents, whether electronic or otherwise, relating to probate or the administration of estates in the possession of the county clerk of any county to which § 16-16-201(d) applied prior to the effective date of this act shall within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this act, be transferred to the clerk and master of any such county.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect on July 1, 2003, the public welfare requiring it.
