AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 68, Chapter 140, Part 7, relative to automated external defibrillators.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-140-703, is amended in subdivision (2) by deleting the language "is encouraged to register" and by substituting instead the language "shall, within a reasonable time after the placement of an AED, register".


SECTION 2. It is the legislative intent that no fee be charged to implement the provisions of this act.

SECTION 3. This act may be known and cited as the "Doug Archer Act".

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003, the public welfare requiring it.
