AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-2-118, relative to LEA programs to prevent disruptive student conduct.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. (a) Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-2-118(a), is amended by deleting the language "grades one (1) and two (2)" and by substituting instead the following:

grades one (1) through six (6)

(b) Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-2-118(a), is further amended by deleting the final sentence.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-2-118(b), is amended by deleting the first sentence in its entirety and by substituting instead the following:

Each year the commissioner of education will require a report from each LEA to be submitted to the commissioner on or before November 1 of each year on the conflict resolution intervention programs implemented during the previous school year.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005, the public welfare requiring it, and shall apply to school years commencing on or after such date.
