AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55, relative to fees related to driver license suspensions.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-12-129(c), is amended by adding the following language at the end of the subsection:

Notwithstanding any other provision of this title, a person suspended pursuant to § 55-50-502 for failure to satisfy timely a traffic citation shall not be required to pay more than four hundred dollars (\$400) in restoration or reinstatement fees for accumulated offenses requiring a fee as provided under subsection (b) at any one time when the person seeks to have the person's driving privileges restored.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006, the public welfare requiring it, and is hereby repealed on July 1, 2008.
