AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102, relative to authorizing the sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises of certain facilities.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102(13)(A)(i), is amended by inserting the language ", or a non-profit, tax exempt, charitable organization that operates a symphony orchestra," following the language "state, municipal and/or county government".

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102(13)(A)(iii)(b), is amended by inserting the language ", or facility owned by a non-profit, tax exempt, charitable organization that operates a symphony orchestra," following the language "established to operate such facility".

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102(13)(A), is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

(v) A convention center licensed under this subsection shall have the privilege of granting a franchise for the provision of food or beverage (Including alcoholic beverages) on its premises, and the holder of such franchise shall also be considered a convention center under this subsection.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
