AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-3-103, relative to requiring any person who stores, handles, distributes, or delivers alcoholic beverages other than for personal use to have a wholesale or retail license from the alcoholic beverage commission or be an employee of such licensee, except locations where consumption of alcoholic beverages on premises is authorized by statute.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-3-103, is amended by redesignating existing subsection (b) as subsection (c) and by inserting the following language as a new subsection (b):

(b) Except as specifically permitted in §§57-3-207, 57-3-402 and 57-3-403, no person may store any alcoholic beverages unless such person holds a license under §§57-3-203, 57-3-204, or 57-4-101, or is employed by any such licensee, unless such alcoholic beverage is intended for that person's personal or social use.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
