AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 5-6-101, relative to the title of the county mayor.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 5-6-101(d)(2), is amended by deleting the existing language in its entirety and substituting instead the following:

(2) Private acts enacted prior to the effective date of this act, designating the title of the chief executive officer of the county as "county executive" shall remain in full force and effect. No county may redesignate the county mayor as county executive by private act following the effective date of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
