AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 50, Chapter 7, Part 3, relative to appeals of denials of employment security benefits.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 50-7-304, is amended in subsection (h) by adding the following language after the first sentence of such subsection:

Written notification shall be made by certified mail. In such written notification shall be an explanation that further appeals must be conducted within thirty (30) days of the board's final decision by filing a petition for judicial review in the chancery court of the county of such party's residence and that the petition shall be against the Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007, the public welfare requiring it.
