AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 63, Chapter 1, Part 1, relative to sanctions imposed by health related boards.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 63-1-144, is amended by designating the existing language as subsection (a) and by adding a new subsection thereto, as follows:

(b) The division, board or committee shall include in any order in which the payment of costs has been assessed an amount which shall be the maximum amount owed by the license or certificate holder at the time the order is entered. Prior to the expiration of sixty (60) days from the effective date of the order, the division, council, board or committee shall send to the license or certificate holder, by certified mail, return receipt requested, and by regular United States mail, a final costs assessment that shall not exceed the maximum amount in the order.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007, the public welfare requiring it.
