

**PUBLIC CHAPTER NO. 961**

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-4-601, relative to litigation taxes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-4-601(b), is amended by deleting subdivision (6) in its entirety and by substituting instead the following:

(6) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, in counties having a population of:

<u>not less than</u>	<u>nor more than</u>
62,900	63,000
71,300	71,400
182,000	182,100

according to the 2000 federal census or any subsequent federal census, upon the adoption of a resolution by two-thirds majority vote of the county legislative body, a privilege tax on litigation in all civil and criminal cases may be levied in an amount not to exceed twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per case, to be used exclusively for court house security, in addition to those purposes identified in subdivision (b)(1).

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-4-601(b)(5), is amended to add the following population figures:

<u>not less than</u>	<u>nor more than</u>
33,525	33,600

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008, the public welfare requiring it.
